

Chardon Area Chamber of Commerce 2010 Scholarship Fund Guidelines

Any individual who is a resident of the Chardon Local School District (as defined by the Chardon Local schools) who has applied to an accredited vocational, two or four year degree-granting institute of post-secondary education and majoring in the field of business, is eligible to apply for the Chardon Area Chamber of Commerce Scholarship.

Qualifications and Guidelines:

1. The applicant has participated in two (2) extra-curricular or community service activities while enrolled as a student.
2. The applicant has attained a minimum grade point average of 3.00.
3. The applicant should demonstrate character, leadership, ability and service.
4. The applicant must be a resident of the Chardon Local School District.

Application Procedure:

1. Each applicant must complete the application and return it to the Chardon Area Chamber of Commerce by the specified deadline indicated below.
2. Recommendations from two faculty members must accompany the application. Forms are provided with the application.
3. The successful applicants will be awarded the scholarship at an appropriate chamber, school or community ceremony.

Amount of Scholarship:

The amount and number of scholarships awarded in any given year will be determined by the Chardon Area Chamber of Commerce Scholarship Committee.

When to Apply:

Applications will be made available at the Guidance Office of Chardon High School, Notre Dame / Cathedral Latin, Chardon Area Chamber of Commerce office and online at www.chardonchamber.com. Completed applications must either be hand-delivered to the Chardon Chamber office between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, or mailed (postmarked by **April 1, 2010**) to the Chardon Area Chamber of Commerce, 111 South Street, Chardon, OH 44024.
